
Children who undergo procedures encounter many challenges, including unfamiliar environments and separation from parents.

- · Biopsies: liver, kidney, bone marrow, FNA
- · Central lines: insertion and removal
- Diagnostic and therapeutic lumbar puncture
- EEG
- EGD/Colonoscopy
- Eye exam
- · Hearing tests
- · Incision and drainage
- Radiologic studies: x-ray, CT, MRI, Interventional, PET, US, nuclear medicine
- · Simple surgical procedures
- Suture/hardware insertion and removal
- · Wound care and dressing changes
